A MESSAGE ABOUT THE COMMISSION

Over two years ago, various organizations were following independent lines of research to improve the delivery of health services in New York City by making information available to consumers.

These groups felt the time had come for the health consumer to have available factual data on the cost and quality of health services. For years, factual data on the operation of hospitals and other health services was extraordinarily difficult to come by for the average consumer. The consumer was asked to place his trust in the professional advice given to him. Most professionals assumed that consumers should have no voice in the decision-making process.

It seemed obvious to many of us, that the 1970's would be the decade of the consumer in American medicine. Millions of Americans today are stunned by the catastrophic cost of hospital and medical care. We believe that individual consumers, as well as large purchasers of health services in New York, must have a voice in the evaluation and delivery of routine and critical life-saving services. The full disclosure of factual data on health services, particularly hospitals, can lead to more intelligent use of the system by consumers.

It is extremely important for the health consumer to know that he is in a position to negotiate for the health services he needs rather than be overwhelmed by the vast and complex health establishment in New York. As a result of these concerns, various groups merged to develop the Consumer Commission on the Accreditation of Health Services.

The decision was made to incorporate the Commission, develop a Board of Directors and a Professional Advisory Committee, and seek funds to develop a broadbased organization that would collect, evaluate and publish information for health consumers regarding the availability, quality and cost of medical services in New York City.

This is the first time an effort of this magnitude has been undertaken by a consumer organization.

An effort must be made to stabilize the escalating inflationary spiral that produces greater cost to the consumer without any noticeable improvement in the quality or scope of health services.

The vast involvement of government, labor-management health and welfare funds, community groups, the aged, the poor, etc., in the direct payment of health care makes it imperative that we develop an informed public on the operation and cost of delivering health services in New York. Within the coming months, according to the latest information from Washington, various national health insurance programs will again be put before Congress. Intelligent discussion about the forthcoming health insurance legislation and other health issues can only be carried out if the public has access to factual data. Last year, the nation spent \$83 billion for all health services.

The expenditure of this extraordinary amount of money requires ongoing scrutiny and intelligent appraisal. The Consumer Commission on the Accreditation of Health Services is now the first operational not-forprofit, tax exempt organization making vital information on the delivery of health services in the New York City area available to subscriber and membership organizations on a regular basis.

THE COMMISSION'S PROGRAM

THE CONSUMER COMMISSION believes that health purchasers have the right to know the quality of health care that they are buying, the professional competence of the persons delivering the service, and the right of access to pertnient data and facts on public and private health facilities in order to intelligently use the available health services.

Unless you are fully aware of the costs, quality and availability of health services, the failings of present health services and facilities will continue, even under proposed federal health programs.

serve health services consumers in the New York City

It is the first program of its kind in the United States. THE CONSUMER COMMISSION will carry out the following program to provide information for member organizations and subscribers:

COLLECT, analyze and publish reports on the quality, cost and availability of health services in New York City.

EVALUATE health institutions and publish evaluations, in clear easy-to-understand language, that will serve as a guide for health consumers, including the administrators and trustees of labor-management health and welfare funds.

ACCREDIT hospital and other health services that meet clearly defined standards prepared by the Commission.

PROVIDE other important information and data on hospitals, nursing homes, mental health centers, medical groups, drug plans, etc.

Without this information consumers cannot make intelligent decisions regarding the quality and effectiveness of the services provided by health institutions. THE HOSPITAL PROFILE FACT SHEETS ARE DESIGNED TO PROVIDE MEMBERSHIP ORGANIZATIONS AND SUBSCRIBERS WITH THE MOST DETAILED, FACTUAL CONSUMER-ORIENTED INFORMATION EVER MADE AVAILABLE TO CONSUMERS ON INDIVIDUAL HOSPITALS IN NEW YORK CITY.

Hospital Profile Fact Sheets will include hard-to-comeby facts about the administration of the hospital, a comprehensive listing of the owners and Board members, as well as an item-by-item documentation of the services, facilities and staff. No aspect of the hospital services will be left uncovered.

Hospital Profile Fact Sheets will provide membership organizations and subscribers with a complete inventory of hospitals. Health and welfare fund managers and other purchasers of health services will have readily accessible facts that will help determine if a hospital is meeting its commitment to patients in terms of satisfactory services, procedures, personnel and life-saving equipment.

Hospital Profile Fact Sheets will be prepared in an easy-to-read format; providing at a glance, information that might otherwise only be obtainable through long hours of research and inquiry.

AS A SUBSCRIBER AND MEMBER ORGANIZATION of the Consumer Commission on the Accreditation of Health Services, Inc., you will be able to provide your membership and staff with HOSPITAL PROFILE FACT SHEETS that show by hospital:

-the availability of life-saving services and facilities (including intensive, cardiac and emergency care, organ transplants, hemodialysis, etc.):

-the cost, charges and average lengths of stay, by type of service and selected diagnosis:

-the physicians who participate in GHI, HIP, Blue Shield or other programs where the costs for physician services are prepaid or a fee schedule is established as payment in full:

-the physicians who are Board Certified and meet other professional standards.

This information, heretofore unavailable to consumers, will enable health consumers to make intelligent choices of physicians in relation to hospital admission.

HOSPITAL PROFILE FACT SHEET No.1

THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN HOSPITAL PROFILE FACT SHEET NUMBER 1-OWNERS OF PROPRIETARY HOSPITALS LOCATED IN NEW YORK

CITY will help you identify those hospitals that operate to make a profit. These hospitals, owned by partners or corporations, for the most part provide general medical and surgical care. More than half of the admitted patients are hospitalized less than thirty days. The name, address and telephone number, the names of the partners or corporation officers, the names and title of the chief administrative officer, the number of beds by type of clinical service, and the Blue Cross, Medicaid and Workmen's Compensation inpatient daily (per diem) reimbursement rates are shown for each hospital.

Almost every hospital is accredited by the Joint Commission on the Accreditation of Hospitals or the Amer-

ican Osteopathic Association. Accreditation by either agency does not guarantee quality but its absence indicates that the most minimal standards are not being met.

Many of the owners are physicians who practice in the same hospital(s) which they own or have a financial interest. In some cases, the chief administrative officers are related to the owners or are owners themselves. In both instances, there may be a conflict of interest between the medical needs of the patient and the financial interests of the practicing physician-owner or administrator-owner.

The inpatient daily (per diem) reimbursement rates for Blue Cross, Medicaid and Workmen's Compensation are all-inclusive rates with some minor variations in covered services. A complete list of inpatient per day reimbursement rates and an explanation of the covered and excluded services will be printed in a future issue.
